Entries will be based on a "first come, first serve" basis.

Any kind of obscenity, vulgarity, or misbehavior will not be tolerated.

Participants or the CL. will not be allowed to handle the technical equipment.

The organizing committee has the right to disqualify any participant.

The decision of the judge shall be final and binding.

OTSE is subject to the availability of slots.



All tracks used during the event have to be submitted on a pen drive in mp3 format, and videos must be in mp4 format only.

The contingent should not reveal the name of their college under any circumstances.

The organizers should not be held liable for the misplacement of the valuable belongings of the participants.

Strict monetary action will be taken against participants/audiences who damage any college property.

Any offensive content will lead to negative markings.

Any form of cheating will lead to immediate disqualification.

The Organizing Committee has the authority to create, change, or modify the rules for any event at any given point in time according to their preferences



Tube tops, crop tops beyond considerable length and low backs, low neck, and sports bras will not be permitted.

Participants are not allowed to perform bare-chested.

Above mentioned items will not be allowed even if mesh/nude bodysuit and hosiery/tights are worn.

Exceptions can be made for fashion show (only during the performance) participants if informed beforehand.

All costumes are subjected to scrutiny and the judge's discretion will be final.

Costume rules will be applicable throughout the fest.

Participates will wear the props and costume which are permitted by the organizer only during the performance



Entry will be given on a valid current-year college ID card or current-year fee receipt with valid photo ID proof.



Performance Time: 3-4 minutes

Duration: - 2hrs

Only live instruments or synthesizers may be used. No karaoke or pre-recorded tracks allowed.

Participants must bring their own accompanying instruments or accompanists.

Participants can choose any genre or language for their song.
The use of explicit, offensive, or derogatory content will result in disqualification.



Participants: 1-2

Performance time: minimum 2 mins, maximum 5 mins

Rap must be in Hindi or English or hinglish.

A live beatboxer may accompany the rapper (optional).

Participants can perform any rap of their choice, but advantage will be given for original compositions and performance for the theme (Rise of Legends)

Explicit, vulgar, or disrespectful content (towards any individual, group, or religion) will lead to immediate disqualification.



Performance time: 90 seconds
